The 2020 Rocks & Flowers checks in as a blend of 56% Grenache, 39% Mourvèdre, and 5% Carignan. It has more subtle notes of darker fruits and peppery herbs, as well as a hint of violets, and is medium to full-bodied, ripe, and wonderfully textured on the palate. I love its purity as well as its balance, and it should drink well for a decade.

ROCKS AND FLOWERS, 2020

BLEND: 56% Grenache, 39% Mourvèdre, 5% Carignan

CERTIFICATION: Made with 100% certified organic grapes

APPELLATION: Paso Robles AVA

HARVEST: September 7th - October 21st, 2020

VINIFICATION: Native fermented in a mix of concrete and stainless steel tanks. Individual lots pressed based on taste and barreled down. Native malolactic ferment. Stirred once a month.

TASTING NOTES:

Aromatics - Boysenberry jam, graham cracker, dried cranberry, blueberry, thyme, star anise.

Palate Impression - Strawberry jam, peach cobbler, pie crust, licorice. Rich and giving with crunchy tannins and lift. Finishes with blue fruit and structure.
